O R D E R:-

In the G.O.1st read above as amended in G.O.5th read above a Committee under the Chairmanship of Justice Sri P.Ramachandra Raju (Retd.Judge), High Court of Andhra Pradesh has been constituted for the process of applications for establishment of new Para-Medical Institutions, Schools/Colleges of Nursing under Private Sector and to submit recommendations to Government for grant of permission to start the same.

2. In the G.O.2nd read above Rules have been framed for grant of permission for establishment of Colleges of Nursing under Private Sector called as Andhra Pradesh Private Colleges of Nursing (grant of permission to Private College of Institutions and admission into B.Sc.Nursing Course) Rules, 1997.

3. In the G.O.3rd read above orders have been issued sanctioning district wise additional B.Sc.Nursing Colleges and Respiratory Therapy Courses under Private Sector as detailed in the Annexure thereto.

4. In the D.O.Letter 6th read above the Chairman, Selection Committee for Paramedical Institutions etc., has submitted recommendations of the Committee and alongwith other Societies/Institutions, recommended for grant of permission to the President & Correspondent, Srinivasa Educational Academy, R.V.S.Nagar, Tirupathi Road, Chittoor for establishment of Sri Venkateswara College of Nursing at R.V.S.Nagar, Tirupathi Road, Chittoor.

5. In Government letter 7th read above, the President & Correspondent, Srinivasa Educational Academy, R.V.S.Nagar, Tirupathi Road, Chittoor was informed that their application has been recommended by the Selection Committee and requested to fulfill/abide by the conditions as indicated therein within a period of two(2) months from the date of issue of the letter and intimate the fact of fulfilment of the conditions to the Registrar, NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada to enable him to depute a team for inspection of the College of Nursing and on receipt of satisfactory report from the NTR University of Health Sciences, Government will grant permission to establish the College of Nursing.

6. In the letter 8th read above, the Registrar, NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada has informed that on receipt of the compliance report from the President & Correspondent, Srinivasa Educational Academy, R.V.S.Nagar, Tirupathi Road, Chittoor an inspection of Sri Venkateswara College of Nursing at R.V.S.Nagar, Tirupathi Road, Chittoor was conducted. The inspection team have certified that they have physically verified the infrastructural facilities available in the Sri Venkateswara College of Nursing and satisfied regarding the due compliance of all the statutory provisions to start 1st year B.Sc.(Nursing) course. The Registrar, NTR University Health Sciences, Vijayawada has therefore requested to issue necessary directions in the matter.

7. Government after careful examination of the matter hereby accord permission to the President & Correspondent, Srinivasa Educational Academy, R.V.S.Nagar, Tirupathi Road, Chittoor to establish Sri Venkateswara College of Nursing at R.V.S.Nagar, Tirupathi Road, Chittoor and admit a maximum of Thirty(30) students per year for the course. The President & Correspondent, Srinivasa Educational Academy, R.V.S.Nagar, Tirupathi Road, Chittoor is also permitted to have clinical attachment to Head Quarters Hospital, Chittoor for clinical training subject to the following conditions:-

- (1) The Institute shall fulfill/abide by the common conditions intimated in Government Letter No.33935/M2/99-1, Dated:4-11-1999.
- (2) The Institute shall pay clinical attachment fee as per the orders issued in G.O.Ms.No.145, HM & FW (M2) Department, Dated:18-5-1998 for training of their students in Head Quarters Hospital, Chittoor District. Government reserves the right to revise the clinical attachment fee from time to time.
- (3) The Institute shall fulfill statutory provisions of the NTR University of Health Sciences (Affiliation of Colleges of B.Sc.Nursing Course).
- (4) The Institute should also fulfill/abide by the Rules and Regulations prescribed in G.O.Ms.No.145, HM&FW, (M2) Dept., dated:18-05-1998.

8. The permission granted in para-7 above is liable for cancellation whenever the Government forms the opinion that the Educational Agency is not running the College or Institution in the best interests of the students, after giving 15 days notice to the Educational Agency to show-cause, against the cancellation and pass appropriate orders after considering the explanation if any, offered by the agency against the show-cause notice.

He has requested the Government to issue necessary orders.

3. Government after careful consideration of the matter, hereby accord permission to the President, Srinivasa Educational Academy, R.V.S. Nagar, Tirupati Road, Chittoor, Chittoor district for increase of seats from thirty (30) to fifty (50) in B.Sc. Nursing course of their Sri Venkateswara College of Nursing, R.V.S. 2. In the letter 4<sup>th</sup> read above, the Chairman, High Power Committee has stated that the proposal for enhancement of Sri Venkateswara College of Nursing, at R.V.S Nagar, Tirupati Road, Chittoor was received from the President, Srinivasa Educational Academy, RVS Nagar, Tirupati Road, Chittoor, has been forwarded to the Principal, S.V. Medical College, Tirupati (Member Convener, District Level Team, Chittoor Dist) for verification.

3. In the letter dt. 1-7-2017, the District Level Team Tirupati has submitted inspection report in respect of Sri Venkateswara College of Nursing, at RVS Nagar, Tirupati Road, Chittoor Stating that "The Infrastructure Teaching facility Clinical facilities is adequate for to enhancing the B.Sc (N) seats 100"




ORDER:-

The Commissioner of Technical Education, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad is informed that the issue of implementing reservations to Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes/Backward Classes in Engineering Admissions has been examined in detail in the light of the judgement of the Supreme Court in Ritesh R. Shah Vs Dr.Y.L.Yamul AIR 1996 SC 1378 which was relied by the High Court of Andhra Pradesh in its judgement, dated 23-2-2000 in W.P.No. 26404 of 1999 & W.A.No. 795/2000 and batch and also in consultation with Backward Classes Welfare Department. The Legislature Committee on Welfare of Backward Classes, in its meeting held on 24-01-2001 has also discussed about the procedure adopted for the implementation of Backward Classes reservations for admission in Engineering Colleges and other professional courses and observed that the same procedure be adopted as followed in the admissions in the M.B.B.S. course. Besides this, there are certain representations from Backward Classes Welfare Association requesting to follow the judgement of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Ritesh Shah's case in Engineering admissions and to implement the rule of reservation for Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Backward Classes in true spirit.

2. The Andhra Pradesh Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission into Under-graduate Professional courses through Common Entrance Test) Rules, 1993, issued in G.O.Ms.No. 184 Education dated 20-08-1993 stipulate the following reservations, namely:-

- (i) SC's 15%
- (ii) ST's 6%
- (iii) BC's 25% and shall be allocated among the four groups of Backward Classes as follows:-
  - i) Group A - 7%
  - ii) Group B - 10%
  - iii) Group C - 1%
  - iv) Group D - 7%

3. In the case of 'Ritesh R. Shah Vs. Dr. Y.L. Yamul and others' (A.I.R. 1996 S.C. 1378) the Supreme Court held as follows:-

"A student who is entitled to be admitted on the basis of merit though belonging to a reserved category cannot be considered to be admitted against seats reserved for reserved category. But at the same time the provisions should be so made that it will not work out to the disadvantage of such candidate and he may not be placed at a more disadvantageous position than the other less meritorious reserved category candidates. The aforesaid objective can be achieved if after finding out the candidates from amongst the reserved category who would otherwise come in the open merit list and then asking their option for admission into the different colleges which have been kept reserved for reserved category and there after the cases of less meritorious reserved category candidates should be considered and they will be allotted seats in whichever colleges the seats should be available." In other words, while a reserved category candidate entitled to admission on the basis of his merit will have the option of taking admission in the colleges where a specified number of seats have been kept reserved for reserved category but while computing the percentage of reservation he will be deemed to have been admitted as an open category candidate and not as a reserved category candidate".

4. Keeping in view of the judgement of the Supreme Court, the High Court in its order dated 23.2.2000 in batch of W.P. Nos. including Contd..3..



W.P.No. 26404 of 1999 and W.A.No. 795 of 1999 relating to MBBS admissions made by the NTR University of Health Sciences has ordered to fix the meritorious SC, ST & BC category students strictly in order of merit for the general seats adhering to the principles laid down by the Supreme Court in the Ritesh R. Shah's Case and accommodate meritorious students belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe and Backward Classes students by deleting the other students allotted in the open competition from the list and resultant equal number of vacancies shall be filled up by drawing the other meritorious candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe and Backward Classes communities who will be next eligible. Therefore, it is clear that the resultant vacancies shall be filled by the students belonging to the respective reservation categories only.

5. After careful consideration and due examination of the issue relating to implementation of reservation for Schedule Caste/Schedule Tribe and Backward Classes in Engineering and other Professional Courses the following instructions are hereby issued.

- (i) In the counselling process, the seats to be filled by open competition should be filled up first, wherein the candidates should be called for counselling based on merit alone irrespective of whether they belong to S.C., ST or B.C. in accordance with the instructions issued by the Government in G.O.Ms.No. 996, Employment & Social Welfare, dated: 11<sup>th</sup> November, 1975.
- (ii) Next, reservation categories like SC/ST/BC candidates will be counselled to fill up the seats earmarked for them in their respective categories. During this process, if a candidate belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Backward Classes who had taken admission under open competition, opts for a better branch or a better college of his choice for which he or she would be eligible as per the rules of reservation, the seat vacated by him or her in open competition shall be filled with a candidate from the same reservation category only, in order of merit.

6. Necessary amendments to the Andhra Pradesh Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions into Under-Graduate Professional Courses through Common Entrance Test) Rules, 1993 issued in G.O.Ms.No.184, Education.dt.20-8-1993 shall be issued separately

7. The Commissioner of Technical Education, Andhra Pradesh, the Chairman, A.P. State Council, for Higher Education shall take further action to follow the above instructions, in implementing the rule of reservation to SC/ST/BCs in admissions of Engineering, B.Arch., B.Pharmacy and other professional courses through Common Entrance tests. The Commissioner of Technical Education shall send necessary proposals for amendment of the said rules at the earliest.
