And whereas both the parties felt it desirable and necessary to have the terms and conditions agreed upon put in writing. Now therefore the indenture is made as shown below:

- 1. The first party ,after proper enrolment and complying with the procedures by the second party ,shell ensure regular lifting of all items of Biomedical Waste, as defined under relevant act under rules made their under common from the premises of the second party on a regular basis and normally within 24 hours but not beyond 48 hours of its generation it is clarified that Biomedical Waste includes all categories as defined under relevant act and rules but does not include food waste sweep dust, packing paper including cartoons for medicine, polythene are other waste bags and such other generally terms which are not considered to be items of Biomedical Waste.
- 2. The first party will provide non chlorinated plastic bags with bar coding on payment basis to the second party and it shall be the responsibility of the second party and sure segregation of biomedical waste generated in their premises every day in the bags by their own staff and get them sealed and kept at a particular spot as identified by both the party to enable the collection of the same by the staff of the first party.
- 3. The second party will make available needle destroyers/ 10% sodium hypochlorite in their premises and has to ensure that all disposable syringes and needles are destroyed including syringes heads immediately after use and does ensure prevention of any reuse are misuse of used syringes and needles since reuse is dangerously hazardous.
- 4. The first party or there nominee will issue a proper receipt or acknowledgement of lifting of Biomedical Waste from the premises of second party regularly to be counter signed by the second party or their nominee. Why implementing bar coding a digital manifest will be mailed to the second party
- 5. The second party shall make payment of prescribed charges for the services rended by the first party onion monthly basis. This charges liable for revision by the first party in consultation with AMW technical committee and will be intimated in advance to second party the monthly payments have to be made on or before 5th of every month in advance and any circumstances. The Bed strength as shown by the second party while obtaining

- authorization from AMW are the actual bed strength which river is higher will be taken for calculation purpose of bed strength.
- 6. If the second party fails to make payment of monthly charges consecutively for 2 months or is found to be regularly regular, the first party will intimate to the AP PCB and stop collection of Biomedical Waste after 15 days of such intimation in such cases command the description for Re enrollment of the second party lies within the first party after the receipt of all accumulated arrears with interest
- 7. It shall be the soul responsibility of the second party to update authorisation from AMW after which only the first party will start collection of Biomedical Waste
- 8. Any dispute or difference of opinion between both the parties shall first referred to IMA branches APNA chapter for arbitration failing which the matter will be settled in a court of law.
- 9. Both parties shall share confirm it with all norms, rules and procedures as prescribed from time to time by the appropriate government or other competent authorities as both the parties share joint responsibility to help for the protection of environment from hazardous biomedical waste generated everyday
- 10. Both the parties convenient that either party retains right to terminate the agreement in KS it is not willing to continue further are or not satisfied with the others services by giving a clear notice of 3 months in writing to other party with a copy market.
- 11. Any or all terms and conditions in this memorandum can be amended or modified at any time with the mutual consent of both parties at any time.
