





As per the feedback given by the students on facilities, the salient features of the feedback are as follows :

- Most of the students (96%) were happy with the transportation facilities and adequacy of the buses provided by the college.
- 96% have rated excellent on usage of ICT facility in the classroom and with good wi-fi and internet facilities (84%).
- Majority of the students (94%) have agreed that the laboratories were fully equipped and maintained in good condition for the effective conduction of practicals.
- Students were happy (94%) with the extent of co-curricular and extra curricular activities conducted by the college for the all round development of students.
- Most of the students(90%) gave a positive feedback on the availability of drinking water facility on the campus.
- Students rated high(94%) on the sufficient quantity of the books and journals in the college library for their preparation and reference .
- Students expressed happy feedback (92%) on the well-ventilated classrooms.
- Girl students felt very secured on the campus(88%).
- Very few students (80%) suggested for the proper and clean maintenance of the washrooms as well as the campus (82%) .

- Most of the students (86%) were happy with the overall environment of the college.

The above feedback analysis and report will be reviewed by the college management in order to maintain a one step ahead environment and facilities in the college for better functioning of the college in a more student friendly way .
